### **Canicross**

The Canicross Open World Cup is held as a chase race (chase start). Here two runs belong to one race. On Saturday, the long distance is run (approx. 5 km), with fixed time intervals between the individual starters. On Sunday the short distance (approx. 2 km) follows in the hunting start. Here the participants start in the time intervals, which result from their running time of the long distance of the previous day. For example, if two runners have the same time in the long distance on Saturday, they will start at the same time on Sunday. Whoever finishes first on Sunday is automatically the winner of the pursuit race. Children and youth run the 2 km course on both days.

### **Dogscooter/Bikejöring**

In Dogscooter and Bikejöring the short distance (approx. 2 km) will be run on Saturday and Sunday. However, on Sunday at the second start there will be no chase start, but will start in fixed starting distances with the order from the 2km competition of the previous day.

### **Relay competition**

In addition, there will be a relay competition on Sunday on a 3x approx. 1km course. Only teams that are also registered in the pursuit race are allowed to participate. For the relay three starters from one country are needed. Either 1 runner, 1 bike and 1 scooter or 3 runners.

## CANICROSS OPEN WORLD CUP 2022

Each country of the FCI has 20 starting places available. Germany, as organizer of the Canicross Open World Cup has 40 starting places available. The maximum number of starters from all nations will be determined as follows:

Canicross:	120 Teams
Dogscooter:	60 Teams
Bikejöring:	60 Teams

If a country does not fill all the starting places it is entitled to, these will be divided equally among the other countries.

All starters must have their primary residence in the country for which they start.

### Qualification results

If the minimum qualification is reached, three starting places are available for each discipline and age group. The other starting places will be allocated according to the performance principle.

#### Canicross:

As qualification results at least the following km average times are required on the long distance (at least 3 km) with one dog. These must be achieved at least twice in the qualification period. Children and youths can also run the qualification on the short distance.

The qualification period for the Canicross Open World Cup is from October 3, 2020 to October 9, 2022.

### Entry fee

The entry fee per team is 25,00 € and has to be transferred to the account of the organizer by the participant after publication and announcement of the list of participants. The entry fees remain with the organizer. Children and youths up to the age of 18 are exempt from the payment of an entry fee.

The entries for the Canicross Open World Cup will be made directly by the participant on the online entry platform O.M.A. ([www.hundesportkalender.de](http://www.hundesportkalender.de)). The qualification certificates must also be emailed to Martin Schlockermann ([Martin.Schlockermann@gmx.de](mailto:Martin.Schlockermann@gmx.de)). For young participants a declaration of consent of the parents is additionally required. The closing date for entries at the VDH-OfT is October 9, 2022.
